Sub: - Role of Departmental Monitoring Committee (DMC) for award of B.Tech. Honours Degree. Ref. University Order No. 180 (Est.) of 2018; dated: -26-12-2018

As approved by Honb'le Vice Chancellor, the role of Departmental Monitoring Committee (DMC) of Engineering Departments in School of Engineering & Technology for the award of B.Tech. Honours Degree is as follows:

- 1. The DMC shall be responsible for creating awareness among students about the various MOOCs platforms available for registration of online courses.
- 2. The DMC will assign mentors (preferably in 2ndyear of degree) to students based on faculty specialization and student's interest who will mentor them regarding selection of MOOCs platform and identification of relevant courses.
- 3. The DMC shall notify different platforms for information of concerned students to choose MOOCs courses which may include SWAYAM, NPTEL, EdX, Coursera, Udemy, Udacity etc. The Department shall publish the list of approved MOOC courses, before the commencement of the concerned semester.
- 4. For some MOOCs courses the certificate is awarded mentioning number of contact hours or duration in days/months rather than number of credits earned. In such cases The 'Credit Conversion Table (CCT)' given in Annexure- A will be utilized by the DMC for calculation of credits earned by the student.
- 5. For evaluation, the DMC / Department shall invite applications from eligible students for the award of B.Tech. Honours degree immediately after completion of their degree, preferably within a week.
- 6. In the evaluation process, DMC shall ensure that the course content does not have more than 50% of overlap with a core/elective course in the concerned discipline or with an open elective in any other discipline which the student is authorised to select from the B. Tech curriculum of the University.
- 7. The DMC shall evaluate the applicants on the basis of Interaction/Presentation and recommend the eligible applicants to Dean Academic Affairs for award of B.Tech. Honours Degree in Engineering.
