The following positions are open for nomination:

Vice-President - 3-year term (04-Positions).

General Secretary - 3-year term (01 positions).

Joint Secretaries- 3-year term (04 positions).

Treasurer, 3-year term (01 positions)

Member (Executive Committee), 3-year term (10 positions).

Note: The position of one Vice-President and one Joint-Secretary is reserved for outstation members, two members of Executive shall be reserved for females.

You may nominate yourself or another member by placing the name and position nominated for in a mail/Google form (Link given below) to Returning Officer at alumniassociationiust@gmail.com The complete list of association members is attached as annexure-A.

Nominations must be received no later than 11th September 2026.

Association Election Manual

A. Association office bearers includes:

1. **President (Reserved for Honorable Vice Chancellor of IUST)**
2. Vice-President - 3-year term (04-Positions).
3. General Secretary - 3-year term (01 positions).
4. Joint Secretaries- 3-year term (04 positions).
5. Treasurer, 3-year term (01 positions)
6. Member (Executive Committee), 3-year term (10 positions).

B. Election Process:

1. Issuing Notification & Inviting nominations from eligible members of Alumni Association.
2. Submission of nominations to Returning Officer (RO) within the date specified
3. Withdrawal of candidature.
4. Date of elections
5. Announcement of results
6. Oath of elected members by RO

C. Schedule for Elections: Dates and mode of election will be announced separately.

D. Nominations are invited for the below following positions:

Vice-President

- Any life member of the association is eligible to file nomination

General Secretary

- Any life member of the association is eligible to file nomination

Joint Secretary

- Any life member of the association is eligible to file nomination

Treasurer.

- Any life member (preferably from awantipora, local resident) of the association is eligible to file nomination

Executive Members:

- Elections will not be conducted for Executive members.
- Members should be nominated by the elected body of the association

E. General Rules for elections

1. Eligible Alumni (only ordinary or life members) of Alumni Association of Islamic University of Science & Technology (AAIUST), can cast their vote in elections.
2. Only life members can file the nomination to assume the charge of office bearers of AAIUST. An ordinary member (if any) applying for enrolment in the electoral roll (nominations for office bearer duties mentioned in A. from 2 to 5), shall have to convert his ordinary membership into life membership by paying an amount of Rs. 900/- towards the AAIUST. The proof of the payment must be attached along with the application form.
3. Tenure of all the office bearer members would be three (03) Years.
4. Once the nominations are finalized, voters list will be sent to all the eligible (registered) alumni of the association for voting. Corrections in the voter's list (i.e. addition of new appointees/ deletion of any), will be accepted till 2 days before the election date.



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5. Each nomination should be proposed by at least '2' members of the association.
6. Same member cannot propose multiple candidates for the same position.
7. One candidate can file nomination for ONLY ONE POSITION.
8. Incomplete nomination papers will be rejected. Any overwriting on the nomination paper should be initialed by the candidate before its submission else the nomination paper will be rejected.
9. Any candidate may withdraw his/her candidature by writing through Email to the returning officer by the date to be notified separately,
10. The final list of the valid nomination(s) shall be notified by the Returning Officer after the last date of withdrawal of nominations.
11. After withdrawal of nominations, if more than one nomination is filed for any post of the Association, election for that post will be held as per schedule. However, if the number of valid nominations does not exceed ONE for any post of the Association, the candidates so nominated shall be declared duly elected to that post.
12. Each voter can cast a maximum of one vote each for Vice-President, General Secretary, Joint Secretary, Treasurer and Member (Executive Committee) of the AAIUST.
13. Canvassing for votes on grounds of caste, creed, region, religion, community or language is strictly prohibited.
14. Violation of any of the notified rules may lead to cancellation of the candidature.
15. If nominations are not received for any position, re-election shall be conducted for the vacant position.
16. In case of any TIE between the candidates, TIE will be resolved by the nomination of the candidate by President AAIUST and shall be treated as final.
17. Bye laws shall be circulated among the eligible members.
18. All rights of decision / interpretation or clarification of the foregoing shall vest in the Returning Officer whose decision shall be final.
