The festival aims to provide a platform to students to explore their creative potential through various literary forms, including on-spot essay writing, poetry recitation, debate competition and *Lal Vakh* reading. Meanwhile, a short film based on the essence of Lal Ded, produced by Department of Journalism and Mass Communication, IUST, shall be screened on the occasion.
