IUST Organizes Symposium on Promotion of Peace and Protection of Environment under the Message of Ramadhan

Awantipora, March 25: The Department of Islamic Studies, Islamic University of Science and Technology (IUST), organized an Interdepartmental Symposium on the Promotion of Peace and Protection of Environment under the banner 'Message of Ramadhan'. The event brought together scholars, faculty members, and students to reflect on the spiritual and social teachings of Ramadhan, emphasizing peace, compassion, and environmental stewardship.

Prof. Ayaz Hassan Moon, Dean Academic Affairs, IUST, was the Chief Guest, while Dr. Afroze Ahmad Bisati, Dean, School of Humanities and Social Sciences, attended as the Guest of Honour. The event was also attended by Prof. G.N. Khaki, Director, Centre for Spiritual Studies, and Dr. Showkat Hussain, Head, Department of Islamic Studies, along with directors, deans, heads of departments, university officers, scholars, and students.
