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IUST holds vigilance awareness program

Awantipora, Sept 16: As part of the Preventive Vigilance Campaign, the Department Vigilance Officer (DVO), Islamic University of Science and Technology (IUST), Mr Javaid Ahmad Khan in collaboration with the Dean Outreach, Dr. Ruheela Hassan, organised a Vigilance Awareness Programme at IUST Main Campus on Wednesday.

The programme focused on promoting awareness about the importance of integrity, transparency and accountability in institutional and public life.

Speaking on the occasion, Mr. Khan emphasised that a corruption-free system can be strengthened by fostering a culture of openness, transparency and accountability. He stressed the need for robust institutional practices that encourage ethical conduct, responsible decision-making and adherence to established procedures.

Highlighting the role of youth in combating corruption, he said, young people have an important role in shaping a society founded on honesty, integrity and responsibility. He underscored the role of Higher Educational Institutions in nurturing these values, observing that universities, besides imparting knowledge, have a responsibility to cultivate ethical and socially responsible citizens.

He further emphasised that preventive vigilance is not limited to identifying irregularities but involves creating systems and practices that minimise the scope for them in the first place. Collective commitment, he said, is essential for strengthening public trust and building institutions grounded in integrity.

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
