Subject: Ramanujan Fellowship award to Dr. Aamir Mushtaq, Physics, Islamic University Of Science And Technology, Awantipora, Pulwama, JAMMU AND KASHMIR - 192122.

1. This is in continuation of SERB/ANRF sanction order No. "RJF/2025/000091" dated "04 February, 2026 " of Anusandhan National Research Foundation (ANRF).

2. Sanction of Anusandhan National Research Foundation (ANRF) is hereby accorded to the transfer of the above Fellowship/project from **University of Hyderabad , P.O. Central University Campus, PROFESSOR C.R. RAO RAOD, GACHIBOWLI** to **Islamic University of Science and Technology , Awantipora** with all assets procured in this project. The revised total allocation will be as under:

3. The effective date of transfer of the project is: 01 April, 2026.

4. The revised total cost of the project at **University of Hyderabad , P.O. Central University Campus, PROFESSOR C.R. RAO RAOD, GACHIBOWLI** would be Rs. 520000 and total cost for **Islamic University of Science and Technology , Awantipora** would be Rs. 11380000. The project duration is till 11 January, 2031.

5. The **University of Hyderabad , P.O. Central University Campus, PROFESSOR C.R. RAO RAOD, GACHIBOWLI** is directed to transfer the unspent amount of Rs. 0 to **Islamic University of Science and Technology , Awantipora** and to settle the accounts with the **University of Hyderabad , P.O. Central University Campus, PROFESSOR C.R. RAO RAOD, GACHIBOWLI**.

6. Sanction of the competent authority is hereby also accorded to the assignment limit of Rs. Rs. 19,60,000/- (Rupees Nineteen Lakh Sixty Thousand only) under 'Grants-in-aid General' to **Islamic University of Science and Technology , Awantipora** being the 2nd installment of the Fellowship/project during the financial year 2026-2027 for implementation of above said project .

7. Sanction of the competent authority is also accorded to utilize unspent balance of Rs. 0 (Recurring Rs. 0 from FY 2025-2026 to FY 2026-2027) for the same purpose for which it was sanctioned within three months of issue of this order.

8. Sanction of the assignment is subject to the conditions as detailed in Terms & Conditions available at the ANRF website.

9. The assigned limits have to be utilized for the purpose, within the financial year. Financial year carry forward will not be allowed. Funds will automatically lapse at the end of each financial year.

10. It will be the responsibility of the Implementing Agency (IA) in coordination with the PI to intimate well in time should the institution be unable to utilize the limits assigned so that the assignment in excess of the requirement can be withdrawn by ANRF.

11. After completion of the project unspent assignment, if any, will be withdrawn by ANRF, intimation of the same should be sent on time to ANRF.

12. The institutions shall not transfer the assignments to any other account nor divert the same to Fixed Deposits/ Flexi-Account / Multi-Option Deposit Account / Corporate Liquid Term Deposit (CLTD) account, etc. in any manner whatsoever. The assignment released to the institute shall not be parked in any bank account of any other agency. Direct payments through PFMS to be made to vendors/suppliers using Digital Signature Certificate (DSC).

13. This assignment is being made under Ramanujan Fellowship (General).

14. The Sanction has been issued with the approval of competent authority under delegated powers on **01 July, 2026** and vide Diary No. **ANRF/F/4561/2026-2027** dated **01 July, 2026**.

15. The assignment limit of **Rs. 19,60,000/-** (Rupees Nineteen Lakh Sixty Thousand only) will be drawn by the DDO of the ANRF and assigned to the institution through the savings bank account opened for the ANRF Scheme 1023 as per the details given below:

17. As per Rule 234 of GFR 2017, the sanction has been entered at S. No. 2026 AP/6051 in the register of grants maintained for the program Ramanujan Fellowship.

18. The institute will furnish to the ANRF, separate Utilization Certificate (UC), financial year-wise for Recurring (Grants-in-aid General) & Non-Recurring (Grants for creation of Capital Assets) and an audited statement of accounts pertaining to the grant immediately after the end of each financial year (as per 12 A of GFR 2017).

19. The institute shall ensure the compliance of OM. No. 1/(18)/PFMS/FCD/2021 dated: 9th March 2022 and OM No. 3/(06)/PFMS/2023 dated 5th February 2024 of the Department of Expenditure, Ministry of Finance and subsequent directions issued thereafter.

20. Overhead expenses are meant for the host Institute towards the cost for providing infrastructural facilities and general administrative support etc.

21. The research personnel sanctioned in the project, if any, are co-terminus with the duration of the project and ANRF will have no liability to meet the fellowship and the salary of supporting staff, if any, beyond the duration of the project.

22. The institute will maintain separate book of accounts for the project.

23. As per rule 211 of GFR the accounts of Grantee Institution shall be open to inspection by the sanctioning authority / audit whenever the institute is called upon to do so.

24. The investigator/host institute must acknowledge the support provided to them in all publications and any other output emanating from the project/program funded by ANRF, along with the project file number RJF/2025/000091.

25. The institute should ensure that the technical support/financial assistance provided by the ANRF should invariably be highlighted/ acknowledged in the opening paragraphs of their Annual Report.

26. As and when required, separate governance guidelines will be released for the technical review and financial monitoring of the sanctioned projects as issued by ANRF and will be reviewed by SEC.

27. Health, safety and environmental-related government norms, as issued from time to time and given at ANRF website are required to be followed by all beneficiaries of the project, including PI and research personnel involved. ANRF will not be accountable for any legal consequences of noncompliance with safety norms.

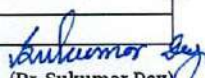
