Following Promotion Policy may be adopted for 10 semester course.

- A student cannot be promoted to next semester, unless, he/she has not passed the Architectural Design course/paper of the preceding semester/s.
- Student who has not cleared Internal Assessment shall not be eligible to appear in the end semester examinations.
- Student who has not cleared Internal Assessment for any subject (credits) will have to re-register for such subject (credits) in the subsequent odd/even semester.
- student must register/repeat a maximum of 36 credit hours in a semester.

“The word **Courses** shall be replaced with **Credits** “



Notification

It is notified for information of all the concerned that the following amended Examination Statutes shall be effective from the year /batch -2017 and shall read as under;

I. Statute 21.2 para 3 shall read as

a) A student shall be required to pass the internal assessment (all components taken together) of each paper to be able eligible examination in that particular paper.

II. Statute 21.5 Supplementary examination shall read as

a) Supplementary examinations shall be held only for the last two semesters in all programmes
b) Students having backlog in any paper(s) of other semesters shall be allowed to appear in examination with regular students as and when the said exam is conducted. However, such students shall appear as backlog candidates with the syllabus applicable to them.

III. Statute -21.12 shall have the heading Calculation of CGPA and shall read as

- a) A student should have obtained CGPA of 5 or more for promotion to next semester
- b) The CGPA shall be calculated at the time of admission/ promotion to 3rd, 4th and 5th semesters in case of courses comprising 4,6 & 8th semesters respectively.
- c) The student having CGPA less than 5 shall not be promoted to next semester. However, such students shall be allowed to improve their CGPA by appearing in examination in maximum of 4 courses of previous semester/(s) as and when the examination of such papers/semester(s) is conducted. There shall be no special examination for any candidate on this account.

IV. Statute 21.13 Promotion rules shall read as

v) Statute 21.14 Repeating of Course shall read as

Clause 'a' and 'b' shall be treated as deleted, clause 'c' shall read as under;

The students who do not meet the mandatory attendance requirement in any particular course at the end of the semester shall have to repeat the course as and when offered next.
