ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION TO B. ARCHITECTURE PROGRAM

As per the Council of Architecture guidelines, the eligibility criteria for admission to B. Arch program is given as

- 1. No candidate shall be admitted to architecture course unless she/he has passed 10+2 or equivalent examination with Physics and Mathematics as compulsory subjects along with either Chemistry or Biology or Technical Vocational subject or Computer Science or Information Technology or Informatics Practices or Engineering Graphics or Business Studies with at least 45% marks in aggregate or passed 10+3 Diploma Examination with Mathematics as compulsory subject with at least 45% marks in aggregate.
- 2. The candidate needs to qualify an aptitude test in Architecture conducted either by NTA (i.e. JEE Paper 2A) or "NATA" conducted by the Council of Architecture.
- 3. Weightage of 50% marks shall be given to the aptitude test (NATA/JEE Paper 2A) & 50% marks in the qualifying examination (10+2 or 10+3) for admission to B-Arch. Course.
