M.A in English

The Master's program in English offers subjects ranging from Contemporary British Literature to Indian Writing in English, from World Literature to Contemporary Critical Approaches with a wide range of fiction, non-fiction, drama and poetry from the 19th and 20th centuries. Deeper understanding of canonical and innovative approaches to English literature is apportioned through different courses covering significant literary texts and movements from the age of Chaucer in the 14th century to the present. Special emphasis on current debates in Literary Theory, lesser-known but significant literatures and courses in Linguistics give students an insight into the structure and the function of natural languages as a system of cognition and communication. With the introduction of the Choice Based Credit System, the students are encouraged to select courses from literature and also other disciplines.
