CHENAB BOYS HOSTEL

Chenab Boys Hostel is a resident hostel for full-time male students and research scholars enrolled at IUST. Situated on the University's main campus, the hostel was established in 2020 to offer a comfortable, homely atmosphere for its residents. The hostel's administration is led by the Provost, supported by the Warden, Assistant Warden and Office Assistant, who manage internal affairs and daily discipline.

This four-story concrete building includes 114 rooms designed to accommodate up to 290 students in three-bed rooms. Each resident is provided with a study table, chair, steel almirah, and bed.

The hostel is built in a manner so as to provide natural light and ventilation to all rooms. Filtered water is dispensed through coolers to meet the drinking water requirement of residents. The bathrooms have running water for 24 hours a day. A Browsing Centre is provided for residents with 24/7 free internet access. The hostel also ensures an uninterrupted power supply with the help of Inverters and a generator set. For recreation, students have access to ample sports facilities.

Meals are served in a dining hall, where breakfast, lunch, tea, and dinner are provided. The hostel places strong emphasis on serving hygienic, nutritious, and high-quality food. The mess operates on a no-profit, no-loss basis and is managed by the students themselves under the supervision of Assistant Warden. To maintain transparency, a dedicated Mess Committee, including the Mess President (a student member), the Mess Manager, and other student members, oversees the mess operations. This structure encourages accountability and fosters an open, collaborative approach to managing dining services.
