SADR-E-MOUJ BOYS HOSTEL

The Sadr-e-Mouj Boys Hostel offers on-campus housing for full-time male B.Sc. Nursing students enrolled at Alamdar Memorial College of Nursing and Medical Technology. Situated on the main campus in Charar-i-Sharief, Budgam, this hostel was established in 2024 to provide a comfortable, home-like environment for its residents. The hostel's administration is managed by the Provost, with support from the Office Assistant and Warden, who handle daily operations and uphold discipline.

This four-story concrete building includes 30 rooms, each designed to accommodate up to three students, totaling a capacity of 84 residents. Each room is furnished with essential amenities, including a study table, chair, steel almirah, and bed. The building is designed to optimize natural light and ventilation for all rooms. Filtered drinking water is provided through coolers, and residents have access to running water in bathrooms 24/7. The hostel ensures an uninterrupted power supply through generator set. For recreation, students can access various sports facilities.

Meals are served in a spacious dining hall, providing breakfast, lunch, tea, and dinner. The hostel maintains high standards of hygiene and nutrition, with meals prepared on a no-profit, no-loss basis. The Mess is student-managed under the Warden's supervision, with a Mess Committee consisting of the Mess President (a student representative), the Mess Manager, and other student members, overseeing dining operations. This setup fosters transparency, accountability, and shared responsibility in managing dining services.
