About the Workshop

esearch, in common parlance, has been understood as a complex endeavour that is systematically conceptualised, planned and undertaken to achieve specific objectives. Quality research has been at the centre of much debate in academic policy circles. To some extent, the debate stems from the widespread belief that research in whichever discipline it is carried out, lacks the overall research framework, credibility, validity and rarely contributes to the existing body of knowledge. As such, it becomes important to reorient and upgrade the research abilities of research scholars so that they keep pace with the changing mode and increasing volumes of data. There is the concomitant need to apprise scholars not only of the different types of data source but also of the ways and means of accessing these. It is here that Research Methodology Workshops open up a trajectory to acquaint scholars with procedures/techniques that enable them to identify, select and analyse data. In particular, Research Methodology Workshops in Arts and Literatures help develop an in-depth understanding not only of the process of content analysis but also of the theoretical approaches used to conduct research. While the process of content analysis involves specific approaches to explore the stylistic and thematic concerns of a work of art, the choice of theoretical approach/s is determined by the type and objectives of the literature research being conducted.

To provide an apposite exposure to researchers, the department of English Language and Literature, Islamic University of Science and Technology, Awantipora, Kashmir shall be holding a One-weekResearch Methodology Workshop in Arts and Literatures.

The event will cater to scholars from the disciplines of English, Urdu, Arabic and Persian Literatures to enable them produce not only substantive and sophisticated research but also help them exchange innovative views to stimulate critical interdisciplinary discussions.

Besides developing research skills amongst scholars and help them keep pace with the recent advancements, the One-week Research Methodology Workshop in Arts and Literatures aims to address the following themes:

- Research methods and techniques of data collection, data analysis and interpretation
- Searching/identifying research gaps and research theme, conducting literature review and formulating research questions/objectives
- Theoretical and philosophical dimensions upon which research in literary studies is based
- Research Methodologies; selecting the relevant or appropriate research methodology for a chosen research topic and questions; understanding the place of different research methodologies in multi disciplinary and interdisciplinary contexts; interdisciplinary methodological paradigm of studying texts
- Summarizing and synthesizing the arguments/ ideas of existing knowledge/previous research in a particular area; accessing and processing themes/ideas in literature from different perspectives
- The three cardinal sins of publishing: fabrication, falsification, and plagiarism
- Locating relevant digital and online resources; formatting in accordance with MLA Style sheet and citation guidelines
