## Rumi Library's User Awareness Programme held at DJMC

He urged the academic and research community to shift from traditional concepts of libraries to more dynamic and digitally integrated systems.

Earlier, welcoming the guests, Dr Rabia Noor, Head DJMC, informed the Librarian about the idea of setting up a departmental library proposed by the department, and sought his support for the same. The programme concluded with a formal vote of thanks by Dr Arif Nadaf, Assistant professor DJMC.
