Awantipora, August 18: As part of its continued outreach initiatives to strengthen school–University engagement, the Islamic University of Science and Technology (IUST), Awantipora, hosted a group of 58 students from Delhi Modern Public School, Pampore, on Tuesday for an educational campus visit coordinated by the Office of the Community connect Under the aegis of Dean outreach.

The visiting group, accompanied by four faculty members, was introduced to IUST's academic ecosystem through interactive sessions and guided visits to the Department of Physics, Department of Chemistry, the Rumi Library, and the Polytechnic College, where students also explored laboratory facilities and gained first-hand exposure to scientific learning environments.

The sessions were facilitated by the Departmental of community coordinators/faculty members/staff who interacted with the students and shared insights into academic opportunities and practical learning at the University.

During the visit, students gained valuable exposure to laboratory-based learning, innovative scientific ideas, and the safe handling of chemicals in laboratory settings. They were also sensitised to the importance of libraries and the role of reading in academic and personal growth.
