One-Day Technology Exposure visit to students of Aspire Heritage School, Srinagar.

Awantipora, **September 18, 2026**: As part of its continued outreach initiatives aimed at strengthening school-university engagement, the Islamic University of Science and Technology (IUST), Awantipora, hosted a group of 91 students from Aspire Heritage School, Srinagar, on 18 September 2026. The educational visit was coordinated by the Office of Community Connect under the aegis of the Dean Outreach, IUST.

The visiting group, accompanied by 12 faculty members, was introduced to the University's academic and technological ecosystem through interactive sessions and guided visits to various laboratories of the Department of Mechanical Engineering. The students visited the **Robotics Lab, CNC Lab, Energy Systems Lab, Additive Manufacturing Lab, and Computational Lab**, where they gained first-hand exposure to advanced laboratory facilities, scientific learning environments, and practical applications of engineering concepts.

The sessions were facilitated by the Departmental Community Coordinators, faculty members, and technical staff, who interacted with the students and provided insights into academic opportunities, emerging technologies, and the importance of practical and experiential learning in higher education.

The visit provided the students with valuable exposure to laboratory-based learning, innovative engineering applications, and contemporary scientific and technological developments, thereby fostering curiosity and encouraging them to explore opportunities in science, technology, and engineering.
