IUST organized workshop on air pollution caused by e-waste

Awantipora, 29 November: CIED IUST organized a one-day workshop on "Air Pollution caused by e-waste: assessment and management" at the Islamic University of Science and Technology, Awantipora.

Shri Tariq Ahmad Wani (Additional SP Traffic Central, JKP), Dr. Parvaiz Ahmad Mir (Director CIED), and Dr. Aijaz Qureshi (Coordinator Biodiversity Park) addressed the participants the students and faculty members during the workshop. Mr. Tariq Ahmad Wani gave a detailed presentation highlighting the causes of air pollution and its impact on human well-being. He said such workshops are essential in sensitizing all society's stakeholders to contribute to protecting the environment.
